Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

It is time for another newsletter article. It is the beginning of April and I have no idea what to write about.

Easter has just occurred, Pentecost is in 50 days, and there is no major holiday to really talk about (well Memorial Day is in two months)

So what should we talk about?

Ever notice we don't like much quiet time?

Have you ever observed people just sitting there? We don't see much of that anymore as our lives seem to be filled with noise, more noise, and some more noise.

Sometimes in worship if you notice I will take time out and let there be quiet for a brief moment. What do you think during that time? Pastor forgot where he is? He can't remember what goes next?

Now understand I was brought up the same as you I don't like much quiet time either. One of the reasons I like noise is I have tinnitus. My ears hear noise all the time, and I have outside noise to take the place of what I get to listen to all the time.

But what must it be like to sit in the quiet stillness and hear absolutely nothing?

Imagine what it was like for those shepherds back in Jesus day out in the fields taking care of the sheep.

No one to bother them as they quietly watch over the sheep, no leaf blower, no cars, trucks, planes, helicopters or anything like that. No cell phone to bother their day.

What it must have been like.

Sometimes I think we are too connected in today's modern world. We don't leave time for God to be in our lives, we don't take time to be with God in our lives. He tries to talk to us, but we have to tell him, just a minute have to answer this call, just a sec, I need to respond to this text.

How can we have a relationship with God when we don't have any free time?

All too often I am not sure we want to have a relationship with God. Because if we give him time, he might ask us to do something we don't want to do.

Witness this experience of Elijah.

There he came to a cave and lodged in it. And behold, the word of the LORD came to him, and he said to him, "What are you doing here, Elijah?" He said, "I have been very jealous for the LORD, the God of hosts. For the people of Israel have forsaken your covenant, thrown down your altars, and killed your prophets with the sword, and I, even I only, am left, and they seek my life, to take it away." And he said, "Go out and stand on the mount before the LORD." And behold, the LORD passed by, and a great and strong wind tore the mountains and broke in pieces the rocks before the LORD, but the LORD was not in the wind. And after the wind an earthquake, but the LORD was not in the earthquake. And after the earthquake a fire, but the LORD was not in the fire. And after the fire the sound of a low whisper. And when Elijah heard it, he wrapped his face in his cloak and went out and stood at the entrance of the cave. And behold, there came a voice to him and said, "What are you doing here, Elijah?" (1 Kings 19:9-13)

Between this time of Easter and when the rush of events catches back up with you, take time out to listen for the Whispers of God.

For it is in his Whispers that we hear the greatest of messages.
