Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Well it is coming to the end of another year. Not just our traditional year but also our Church Liturgical year.

Have you ever wondered why we as a church even have a Liturgical year? Many of the churches around us don't, and they just pick whatever lessons catch their fancy, and don't have to worry about the color of paraments on the altar or any of the stuff.

Just like our traditional year has season have you ever looked at our Church year to see how it flows and how the seasons are there? We go from the season of Advent, preparation, to the season of Christmas, Celebration. We continue to Epiphany where we see the Christ manifest himself and show his Messiahship to the world. We then go to Lent, where we remember the hard road he had to trod to the Cross, and see that culminate in Holy Week, with Maundy Thursday and Good Friday. We then have the celebration of Easter another high point. Easter continues for a number of weeks where we Follow our Savior as he shares with His disciples the joy of Easter living. Then we have the dual celebrations of Pentecost and Trinity which begin what we call the long green season where we share in the learning of what it means to be Disciples of Christ. During this time we occasionally have feast, and memorial days where events and people of the early Church are remembered. As we get to the end of the Church year we have Reformation Day and All saints Day and then our National Thanksgiving Day.

At this point the church year comes to an end and picks right back up again with Advent.

The church year follows Christ's life all the way through, from His birth to the beginning of his ministry, to his ministry and the choosing of his disciples and then all the way to his triumphal entry into Jerusalem, and even his arrest, trial and death. We follow him to his triumphal resurrection and his ascension into heaven. We even get to celebrate the birthday of the Church with Pentecost day.

Wow what a journey, all around the life of Christ in one year. The liturgical year helps us see the life of Christ and examine it in our readings all through the year. It also helps us not concentrate on just one section of his life and ministry but to see it all, from his humble birth to his triumph in the resurrection of Easter, to his ascension to heaven. We see Christ's miracles, his parables, his teachings, and his relationships with everyone. We experience the struggles and the questions of the disciples, and even experience the denial of Christ by his disciple Peter. We get to see ourselves in this liturgical year.

The church year shows us Christ at work in our lives. The Church year has been given to us to help us see the work of Christ and what Christ has done for us.

So as we draw to the end of another church year, we celebrate the life of Christ, but most of all we celebrate what Christ has done for us, and how he has called us to be his own.
