Dear Brothers & Sisters in Christ,

Last month we touched on our anniversary and change. This month we continue to remind everyone of our anniversary celebration, the end of October but I want us to think of the word transformation.

The end of August marks a terrible anniversary in the Southern District, the anniversary of Hurricane Katrina. Katrina wreaked havoc on our Southern District damaging and causing relocations for untold number of people. Even today not all our churches are back up and functioning as they once were.

Katrina was a natural disaster. Disasters have a way of making us change or transform what we do.

50 years ago, a young woman in Ozark wanted to start a Lutheran Congregation and made contacts and through the hard work of many services started to be held and within a couple of years a congregation was formed in Ozark and they named themselves Prince of Peace. They adapted and changed and did not accept the status quo to cause a Lutheran Church to come into existence.

This is transformation. Not accepting the status Quo and wanting to make change. There is the old joke of how many Lutherans does it take to change a light bulb. Change the answer goes? Lutherans don't change. The upshot of it is, none of us like change. We do not like to go from what we are comfortable with, what we know to something that might make us uncomfortable or that we are unfamiliar with. But sometimes we are confronted by situations and conditions that force us to change and therefore we are transformed!

A long time ago (not in a universe far, far away) Adam and Eve sinned and changed our condition irreversibly. Sin came into the world and changed our relationship with God. God established a relationship with man and made a covenant (or contract) with Abram and declared him a father of many peoples. The problem was God kept his end of the contract, but man did not. Man kept running away from God and breaking the relationship no matter how many times God repaired it. Man did not want to change.

Two thousand years ago, God sent his Son to live and finally die in this world. He did this all for us. God wanted to transform his relationship with us and make us a part of him once more. Part of our calling as God's people today is to be transformed by His Word. Not change but transformation so that we are not the same.

God does not want the status quo to rule. God wants transformation. Are we ready to be transformed? Are we ready to be formed and changed by God? It started when we were baptized and it continues today. God is trying to transform all of us, if only we will let him.

Fifty years is a long time. Last newsletter I talked about all the changes that have taken place in those fifty years. Will we be able to talk about all the changes that have taken place fifty years ago from today? Or will there be no one left to talk about those changes? Are we willing to be transformed or will we settle for the status quo?

Dear Friends in Christ

This year has certainly flown by; over half of 2010 is already behind us.

This year we are starting the budget process early. Steve and Norm are council members on the budget committee. Steve will head the committee; we need two to three members from the congregation to assist in the budget process. See Norm, Steve, or me if you are interested in serving on the committee. There are some decisions that need to be made by the end of September on the church Concordia Plan for Pastor. Most everything else could be put off till later. I am looking for a goal of having the budget ready for consideration by the congregation the last Sunday in October.

The weather has been excellent for grass growing, the mowing schedule is in the back; do not forget to sign up. The mower is running good; so far it has not given any trouble, except it does not want to go into fourth gear. The leaf blower and weed eater are in the boy's bathroom in the educational building. Also an option we are pursuing is possibly hiring a business to do our lawn service, the cost would be around \$70.00 each time the yard was mowed. What would work best is a mowing fund, with a donation from the members on a monthly basis. The council will continue to look at any other possible options.

As I said I will continue mentioning in the newsletter that we always need to keep planning for the future. Keep in mind our organ will need replacing in the not so far future; the approximate cost for a new organ will be in the \$20,000.00 to \$25,000.00 range. Should you wish to designate money for an organ fund, please do so.

We still have one pine tree in need of removal, the dead one in front of the educational building. Two other pines will need removal eventually but they can wait a little longer.

If any other areas are in need of repair please let a council member know.

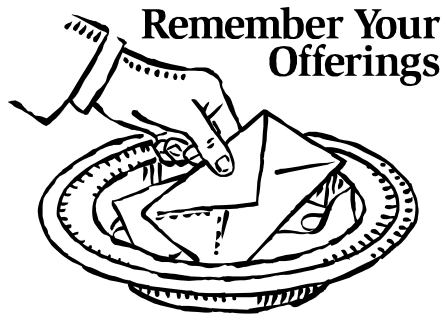
